Then our parents tried their best to provide us with education facilities in South Sudan, but it was hard for us the children to understand and cope up with the system and we used to get into conflicts with children because we used to speak Hebrew which they never understood thinking we are abusing, which made all of us to just stop going to school till the year ended. Then 2013 is when my mother heard of the Come True organization, so we came to Uganda for better education facilities, because every parent wishes for their children to study.
