PROGRAMS Next project!



In the **summer of 2013**, a group of 10 professional volunteers from **Become** will go to the field and participate in the first collaborative action with ABBA. The project will consist of:

- Rebuilding the small community health clinic
- Rebuilding the 2 homes for 26 orphans and vulnerable children
- Purchasing and installing beds, mosquito nets and other important equipment for the homes
- Conduct a nutrition assessment and report
- Conduct a 4-day Community Health Training to key community members
- Vaccinations, testing, deworming and physical exams of the children of the ABBA project
- Educational activities

The ABBA project is a very inspiring self-help local initiative launched in 2007 by its founders, Silvia and Emmanuel. Become team members have visited the project several times over the past 2 years, in order to understand the needs of the project and plan possible interventions. The project is located in the Nyanza province, where people face several social and economic challenges.

ABBA is comprised of a variety of community services: a primary school accommodating 400 students, an orphanage for 26 vulnerable children, a small community / dental clinic, an agriculture initiative and a program of assistance to elderly community members.



The project itself is self-sustainable and already bringing a positive impact for vulnerable groups within the community! However, due to recurring flooding and scarcity of resources, ABBA needs assistance with rebuilding the facilities with more durable materials and equipment such as beds, mosquito nets and daily living resources.

To make it all happen, we need to raise 42,000 USD in the next 5 months! So far, our team of volunteers has raised 16% of this target. Please consider making a donation - big or small! - to help ensure the success of the project!

One year anniversary of the FS2S Scholarships Program!

During the 1st year of the From Streets to Scholars scholarships program, Become provided **9 scholarships** to children. Seven were double orphans who graduated from Heartspring Academy. Two additional students, also orphans, were provided a partial scholarship in order to graduate and obtain their secondary school diploma. The scholars all came from villages located in the Homa Bay District, where **only 23.5**% of youth reach secondary school.

This year, we provided scholarships for 8 more children. Thanks to the ongoing generosity of donors all over the world, the dedication and excellent coordination work of M. Tom Muga, the field visits of Become volunteers and the constant monitoring and follow-up, the process was carried out in an efficient and effective manner.


